
Guru Gobind Singh Ji, born Gobind Das was the tenth and last human Sikh Guru. He was a warrior, poet and philosopher. In 1675, at the age of 9, he was formally made the leader of Sikhs after the execution of his father, Guru Tegh Bhadur Ji by emperor Aurangzeb. His 4 sons died during his lifetime – A life full of sacrifices.

Baba Deep Singh Ji, born in Amritsar district in January 1682, is one of the most hallowed martyrs of the Sikh faith.

At the age of 18, in 1700, Baba Deep Singh Ji met Guru Gobind Singh Ji, the tenth Sikh Guru. At that holy meeting he received the oath of Amrit (baptism) and embraced the Khalsa, the community of initiated Sikhs.

Working with Bhai Mani Singh, scholar Baba Deep Singh Ji extended the Adi Granth.

Having had training from Guru Gobind Singh Ji, warrior Baba Deep Singh Ji engaged Abdali's forces, at age of 75, and despite suffering a fatal blow to his neck, reached the Amritsar Darbar Sahib Parkarma (as he had vowed to do) as martyr on 13th November 1757.

Gen Secretary's Report

Dear Sangat Jee

The New Year commenced with over 10,000 visitors and ANPR recorded app 2,600 cars to the Gurdwara on the day; followed by Guru Gobind Singh's Prakash Gurpurb on 5th January.

Hounslow Gurdwara's ex General Secretary for 12 years (over 4 terms), Mohan Singh Nayyar left for heavenly abode on the 12th January whose *antim sanskar* (funeral) bhog was held on 22nd January.



He arrived in UK at the age of 16 from Singapore in 1961. Originally the family settled in Kent and he studied in Oxford leading to an ambitious career in various departments of Civil Services with lengthy periods in Land Registry and Ministry of Justice. He retired as a Senior Manager in 2000 having demonstrated his outstanding administrative and organisational skills.

Supporting his late father Kartar Singh, who was closely associated with our Gurdwara during its inception, Mohan actively engaged in 1999 enabling the Gurdwara to grow and lay its operational infrastructure in place giving way to putting the Gurdwara on global map – inviting the Late Queen Elizabeth II and Late Prince Phillip, followed by the current King Charles III and Queen Camilla to site.

Mohan Veer had personal relations with everyone and has left fond memories of his personality, his seva, his association with this Gurdwara. He set up a direction strategy to invest in youth, setup surgeries, evolve with changing times and use of technology.

He was also a Magistrate. He retired from his Gurdwara post in 2014 due to ill health but continued guiding the sangat and the Management team.

Estate update – The offer of £2.75m for the Hounslow Business Park was made based on the market value and associated risks.

The adjoining land (209-213 Hanworth Road) is not being developed as DoE has confirmed that the SEN school is not to proceed; as such, the site plans will change. Watch this space for developing information.

An offer to purchase a neighbouring property has been made to increase our footprint and expand parking spaces.






