The Vadda Ghallughara (Major Holocaust) was a mass slaughter of Sikhs by the Afghan forces of Ahmad Shah Durrani on 5 February 1762. It is considered one of the bloodiest and most tragic chapters in Sikh history, occurring near the village of Kup (present-day Ludhiana, Punjab). The massacre was Durrani's attempt to annihilate the Sikhs after they had repeatedly harassed his retreating forces and liberated thousands of prisoners following the Third Battle of Panipat.

- Historical accounts suggest between 20,000-50,000 Sikhs were killed in a single day. Unlike normal battles, the majority of the victims killed were 'non-combatants' (elderly, women and children) who were being escorted to safety in the Malwa region.
- Sikh warriors, led by Jassa Singh Ahluwalia and Charat Singh, formed a moving protective ring around their families, fighting off Afghan attacks from all sides, nearly 50 kilometres.

Despite losing nearly half of their total population at the time, the Sikh community showed remarkable resilience. Just three months later, they regrouped and defeated the Afghan governor, Zain Khan, at Sirhind.

A memorial and Gurdwara Sri Wadda Ghallughara Sahib Rohira now stand at the site to honour the martyrs.

This Holocaust is distinguished from the Chhota Ghallughara (Smaller Holocaust) of 1746, where approximately 7,000–10,000 Sikhs were killed.

The events of both Ghallugharas are remembered by Sikhs globally during the daily Ardas.

**Saka Nankana Sahib**, also known as the Nankana Sahib Massacre, was a pivotal event in Sikh history that occurred on 20 February 1921. It involved the brutal killing of approximately 150 to 260 peaceful Sikh protesters at Gurdwara Janam Asthan in Nankana Sahib (the birthplace of Guru Nanak Dev Ji, now in Pakistan).

The Shaheedi Saka Nankana Sahib was a tragic massacre occurring on February 20, 1921, at Gurdwara Nankana Sahib (now in Pakistan). Over 150-200 unarmed Sikh reformers (Akalis) were killed by Mahant Narain Das's armed men while attempting to liberate the shrine from corrupt management, marking a pivotal moment in the Gurdwara Reform Movement.

# Gen Secretary's Report

Dear Sangat Jee

ਵਾਹਿਗੁਰੂ ਜੀ ਕਾ ਖਾਲਸਾ, ਵਾਹਿਗੁਰੂ ਜੀ ਕੀ ਫਤਿਹ!

WaheGuru Ji Ka Khalsa; WaheGuru Ji Ki Fateh!

This month we mark Sahibzada Ajit Singh ji's birthday, on 11<sup>th</sup> February Nanakshahi, at Paonta Sahib where he was born to Mata Sundri ji and Guru Gobind Singh ji, in 1687. He was brought up in Anandpur Sahib. In common with his three younger brothers, he attended the status of one of the most hallowed martyrs of the Sikh nation. In the Sikh tradition, he learnt swordsmanship, horse riding and archery. He grew into a strong, intelligent and natural leader of men. Soon after the creation of the Khalsa in 1699, he led several rescue battles to save the local populace from injustices. In August 1700, aged 13, he defended Fort Taragarh when Anandpur was first attacked. During a cold December night of 1705, after the 8-month long siege of Anandpur, he took command of the rearguard of the evacuation column. In the second battle of Chamkaur on 21 December Nanakshahi, in the besieged fortress of Budh Chand, Baba Ajit Singh ji attained martyrdom while fighting in a sally of just five Sikhs, against several lakhs of the army of the enemy forces. Armed only with sword and spear, Baba Ajit Singh ji was just 18 years old at the time of his martyrdom.
