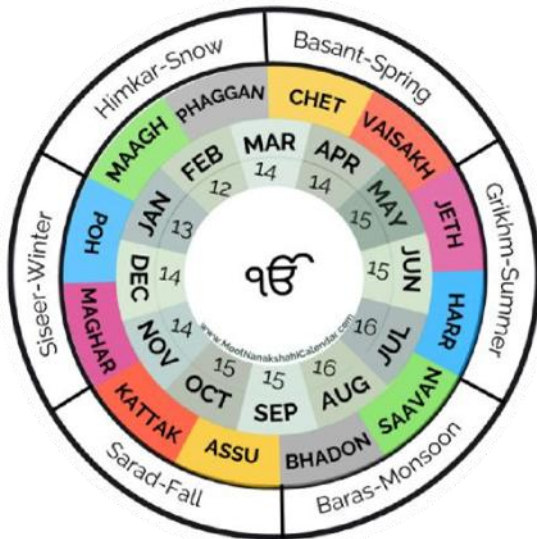

Nanakshahi New Year

This month marks the start of the Sikh Nanakshahi New Year, from 1 Chet (14 March CE) as per the Gurbani Barah Maha seasonal calendar in the SGGs, first composed by Guru Nanak Sahib ji and later by Guru Arjan Sahib ji. This Khalsa Era (KE) Calendar uses the more accurate Solar Tropical year (which keeps the Months and Seasons in sync as per Gurbani) to define the duration of a year; as a consequence, it can offer fixed dates for all Sikh events from year to year. Moreover, it re-inforces the separate Sikh identity, starting with the Parkash year of Guru Nanak Sahib ji as Year 1 KE (1469 CE).

Hola Mohalla

The annual Sikh Hola Mohalla festival was established by Guru Gobind Singh ji to ensure that the Sikhs were physically and spiritually ready for battle at all times. It involves daring horse stunts and displays of fighting prowess & bravery through Gatka, punctuated with Kirtan sessions. Guru Sahib inaugurated the Khalsa saint soldiers at Anandpur Sahib on Baisakhi day in 1699.

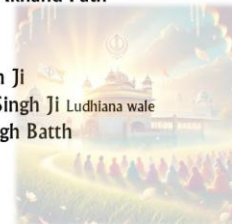

Hola Mohalla – by Jagtar S Thethi

Holi is a colour festival celebrated throughout India mostly by the Hindu population since times immemorial. This occurs in March and marks the end of winter and the beginning of summer. Everywhere young and older people can be seen sprinkling coloured water on each other and singing, dancing and generally enjoying themselves.

In the 18th century however Guru Gobind Singh asked Sikhs to celebrate the festival in a novel way and called the event the Hola Mohalla. All Sikhs started participating in Hola, the festival of display, where young men and women held competitions among themselves, showing skills of swordsmanship, archery, horse riding and many other martial arts.

Since then Sikhs have been enthusiastically celebrating Hola Mohalla. Today its main centres are in Amritsar, Anand Pur Sahib and Mukatsar, where the participants have a chance to show their prowess with great pomp and show. Previously people used to reach Anand Pur Sahib a couple of days before but nowadays devotees arrive there from all parts of India and even abroad. They come in every available vehicle including buses, motor cycles, trucks and trolleys. They may have a holy dip in the sarovar of Takht Sri Kesgarh Sahib and have food from any one of the many langars organised by individual volunteers and organisations, along all the roads leading to the town. Nihang Singhs (Guru di ladli fouj) are the main attraction of the present day Hola Mohalla celebrations. They are keen to preserve their heritage and tradition. They still live in camps called Chhawni, eat from iron utensils called the 'batta' and on the move they progress in formations. They prepare and distribute huge quantities of a rich concoction of sweetened milk, almonds and other nuts.

The Nihangs are probably the most photographed people in the area because of their newly stitched choga and shaster (or weapons). They pay special attention to their dumala or pharhara - the unique conical turban that makes them easy to spot from a distance. Dressed in their saffron or deep blue robes, they move from their chhawnies led by horsemen beating their nagaras. Armed with their traditional weapons, they pay their obeisance at the Takhat Kesgarh Sahib Gurdwara and proceed towards Guru Ka Lahore from where they rush to the sandy bed of Charan Ganga to perform their feats of bravery.

Although the festival lasts for three days, the movements of the devotee lasts for a full week. Hola Mohalla is a symbolic celebration of liberty, freedom, bravery and wisdom, and if need be, preparedness to face an enemy. All the programmes are conducted with a strong sense of sewa and humility, and conducted in the name of the Guru.

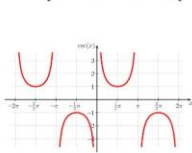

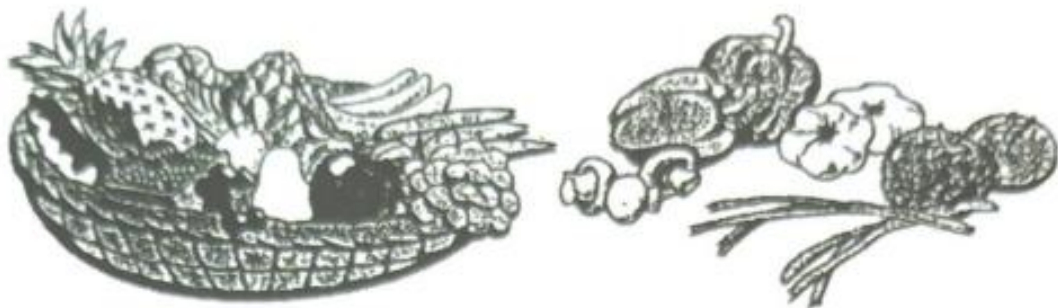
